What is RCIT?

RCIT stands for (Rite of Christian Initiation for Teens). This program is for those who have not received any of their Sacraments of initiation. We are combining Both RCIT <u>and</u> Confirmation into one class because, whether or not a teen needs just one of the sacraments or all of them, the information that they need to know is the same. However, in addition to the once a month classes, teens that fall under the umbrella of RCIT will have a few more responsibilities:

NON-Catholic teens:

- Attend *Breaking open of the Word* every Sunday we have Confirmation/RCIT class during the 10:30AM Mass.
- Partake in the Rite of Welcome (Oct. 7th), Rite of Sending (Mar. 3rd), and the Rite of Election (Mar. 9th). These rites that pertain solely to those receiving all three Sacraments. 10:30AM Mass.
- Participate in the Scrutinies (Mar. 24th, Mar. 31st, Apr. 7th). 10:30AM Mass.
- Will Receive Sacraments at the Easter Vigil (Apr. 20th).
- Catholic Candidates: Will receive Sacrament of Confirmation TBD.

Confirmation/RCIT Class

This is a mandatory, once a month, class that is directed towards a different important topic that every person receiving their Sacraments of Initiation needs to know. <u>A</u> **sponsor or a parent must attend this class** with the each teen going through the program. If a teen misses more than one class, they will be asked to repeat Sacramental preparation classes and will receive their sacraments the following year. Attendance will be taken for both teen and Sponsor/parent.

Other Requirements

- Must attend one retreat with the Youth group.
- · Actively Participate in YG (No more than 5 absences on Youth Group Passport).
- Receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation no earlier than a month before receiving their Sacraments of Initiation.
